The TRTA will require approximately 36 person-months (PMs) of international consultants and 18 PMs of national consultants' inputs. These consultants will be recruited individually. Output based contracts will be maximized to extent possible to achieve administrative efficiency. For project due diligence where feasibility study is already prepared by the Mass Rapid Transit Authority of Thailand (MRTA) following government internal requirements, hiring individual consultants with short duration is more appropriate for quick mobilization of consulting services, and more cost-effective than firms. The consultants will procure goods, mainly in the form of software for use in transport demand modelling. Resource person contracts (maximum 2 PM) will be reserved to allow inputs from highly specialized experts with hand-on experience in rail management and operations, particularly to support capacity strengthening in managing rail operations and preparation of the MRT and multimodal transport network integration plan. ADB will recruit the consultants in accordance with ADB's Procurement Policy (2017, as amended from time to time) and ADB's Guidelines on the Use of Consultants (2013, as amended from time to time).
