Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	Strategic Roadmap's implementation suggests the need for quick and effective support to the government in policy formulation and execution based on international best practice and dialogue with the private sector. ADB has provided rapid response policy reform and capacity building in several developing member countries. Drawing on this experience, a small-scale knowledge support TA project is proposed to expeditiously respond to emerging policy advice and knowledge sharing needs of the Government during 2018 when the intensive phase of the implementation of the Roadmap begins.
