Description	The proposed cluster TA will support the implementation of key activities identified for implementation during Phase 1, including (i) assisting DMCs in refining and translating NDCs to climate investment plans, which may be implemented with ADB assistance, (ii) facilitating improved access of selected DMCs to external public and private climate finance, including support for innovative financing mechanisms, and (iii) developing methods and approaches in establishing baselines and monitoring tools for indicators to measure and gauge DMC progress on climate actions and ADB's contribution to their action. The cluster TA supports the priorities articulated in the MTR of Strategy 2020 and the draft Strategy 2030, the Review of 2011 Financial Sector Operational Plan, and internal ADB directives to promote the use of high-level technology in projects. Three separate but closely interrelated subprojects will be processed under the cluster TA, with each subproject supporting the delivery of each of the outputs. KSTA SP 1: Supporting the Ambitious Climate Action through the implementation of DMCs' NDCs KSTA SP 2: Enhancing financial mechanisms to develop climate actions of DMCs KSTA SP 3: Establishing mechanisms to measure, monitor, and report on commitments made under the Paris Agreement Additional KSTA subprojects supporting activities identified for implementation during Phase 1 of the CCOF2030 action agenda may be added under the cluster TA as required.	

Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy The Climate Change Operational Framework 2017-2030: Enhanced Actions for Low Greenhouse Gas Emissions and Climate-Resilient Development (CCOF2030), approved by the President on 4 July 2017, is intended to provide broad direction and guidance for enhancing resilience and strengthening climate actions in ADB's operations and business processes including country partnership strategies, country operations business plans, sector and thematic strategies, developing member country (DMC) programs and projects, technical assistance, and knowledge support; in accordance with the goal to deliver stronger, better and faster support to its DMCs as "One ADB".

CCOF2030 will be implemented through an action agenda consisting of two operational phases, the first of which, Phase 1 (2017-2023), will support an acceleration in climate change investments and serve as a learning opportunity as ADB scales up climate finance to meet the \$6 billion target by 2020. Phase 2, from 2024-2030, will position ADB to further scale up its assistance in line with lessons learned in Phase 1 while being guided by the second generation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and increasingly ambitious DMC climate action.
