Description	The knowledge and support technical assistance (TA) will contribute to strengthening gender mainstreaming strategies within government stakeholders, specifically select central ministries, state departments, and executing and implementing agencies (EAs/IAs) of ADB-supported projects. To be able to achieve the same, the proposed TA will help, (i) create and strengthen mechanisms that has the ability to plan and incorporate gender responsive measures across sectors in a methodical and systematic manner; (ii) enhance the capacity of concerned officers of the state departments in application of relevant Gender Budgeting (GB) tools; (iii) develop customized resources, on gender responsive planning and budgeting across select sectors and thematic area; and (iv) develop an e governance tool that collates information on women related schemes and entitlements as also examples of gender mainstreaming practices' across sectors and thematic areas.	
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	In India, though the Government has instituted comprehensive laws and schemes, including Gender Budgeting scheme and has established the necessary mechanisms to operationalize the same, yet the effectiveness of such measures, due to weak capacities of government staff, low budget priorities and limited inter-agency synergy and several other bottlenecks are a concern. 7. However, given the size and diversity of India as well as the growing number of stakeholders involved in governance, entry of new staff for new projects, and transfer of trained staff to other government posts, the need for capacity development remains expansive. Moreover, with greater devolution of funds from the union government to state governments through the Fourteenth Finance Commission and the increasing share of funds for state governments to implement development program, it is imperative to invest efforts in GB capacity development at the state level.
