The Program aligned with the operational priorities of Strategy 2030 in tackling climate change, building climate and disaster resilience, and enhancing environmental sustainability. The additionality provided by ADB is in sourcing and using available grant funds for the PDMCs from ADBs development partners as a cree enhancement tool that will mobilize private sector financing. This will spur private sector development, help to reduce continued reliance power utilities on grants and subsidies, and increase renewable energy supply. Technical assistance for projects under the Program will assist in strengthening governance and institutional capacity through building skills in financial sustainability, service delivery, transparer tender processes and E&S standards.
