Description	The TA will support building institutional capacity of DoPT to operationalize Integrated Government Online Training (iGOT) scheme by developing ar intelligent LMS which would offer about 10 e-learning modules to cover about 2,000 civil servants spread across the country on a pilot basis. The proposed LMS will have a multi device access capability (desktop, laptop, tablet and smart phone) to enable on site and on time learning by the civ servants from their duty station without a need to travel to a training center. This approach will enable DoPT to enhance coverage of training programs to a large number of civil servants with lesser resources in terms of cost and time.	
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	Within GOI, DOPT is mandated under the National Training Policy 2012 to cater to the capacity development needs of (National, State and Local Body). However, DOPT's current approach in creating capacity and knowledge base has bus traditional classroom style knowledge sharing trainings. This traditional method poses several constraints, such as li officials, and high administrative cost such as staff travel and per diems. At present, domestic and foreign trainings of mostly senior level officials. As a result, there is an inadequate coverage of training programs for professional stat or undertaking planning, design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of various development schemes, affect implementation of those schemes. In the meantime, the recent technological advancements have opened up a rang based options such as e-learning for creating capacity and knowledge with higher efficiency and effectiveness. Tapp launched a new scheme Integrated Government Online Training (iGOT), under which DOPT intends to develop an LN targeted at professional civil servants working at the operational leadership level to increase the access to new infor operationally relevant training programs to build institutional capacities. This is in line with GOI's flagship program D improve public service delivery using digital platforms. The proposed TA aims to prioritize training topics relevant to procurement, contract management, construction management, project evaluation and appraisal, as well as cross-co new technologies, data analytics, IT tools in governance, and GOI office administrative procedures. ADB has pioneer systems of these project implementation related subjects under the Capacity Development Resource Center (CDRC) Resident Mission (INRM) jointy with DEA. The TA will use the developed CDR materials and knowledge base as refe systems of the LMS under the iGOT scheme.
