Description	ADB was appointed as a Transaction Advisor to develop sustainable project structures and replicable project templates for 1GW solar power plants, which is part of Government's broader 5GW solar energy development strategy by 2030. All subprojects will be developed following an independent power producer (IPP) scheme where a private entity will generate electricity for sale to the power off-taker and recover the operating and investment costs through the electricity tariff. As an IPP will design, finance, build, own, operate and maintain the solar power plants, contracting an IPP avoids the financial pressure for the government to construct and own power plants requiring a vast outlay of initial capital. In many other countries, IPPs are playing crucial roles in adding the power generation capacity and providing security of energy supply with well-structured contractual arrangements and risks allocation.
