Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	The COVID-19 Pandemic. The Kyrgyz Republic is one of the most open and integrated economies in the Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation (CAREC) region with a population of more than 6.3 million and estimated gross domestic product (GDP) per capita of \$1,280. The Kyrgyz Republic is a landlocked country, which means that transit arrangements with its neighbors will be critical. Kazakhstan, to the northwest, is its second largest export market, its third largest investor, and the country's lifeline for all transit trade through to the Russian Federation, the Middle East, and Europe. The People's Republic of China (PRC), to the east, is its largest investor and a major supplier of food and industrial goods (equipment, textile products, and more), which account for 35.4% of total imports. Regional cooperation is key to the country's economic growth through undertaking cross-border trade (including transit trade) with other countries. The Kyrgyz Republic's openness and integration means it is at high risk of exposure to the pandemic and, through its significant migrant population, highly exposed to cross-border contamination.
