ADB's Comprehensive Response to COVID-19 Pandemic includes \$1.8 billion funding for non-sovereign facilities to enable ADB to scale up its support for private entities.21 The project will complement sovereign COVID-19 response projects in South and Southeast Asia22 to provide COVID-19 response for the poor and vulnerable households.
