Description of Outcome	Businesses of eligible enterprises affected by COVID-19 revived and sustained Eligible enterprises must qualify as small and medium-sized enterprises there (i) borrowing for an original principal amount between \$5,000 and \$1 million or (ii) meeting 2 out of the 3 following sub-criteria: (a) between 10 and 300 employees, (b) total assets between \$100,000 to \$15 million, and (c) annual sales between \$100,000 and \$15 million. Eligible enterprises must also qualify as women-led or women-owned businesses by either (i) being at least 51% owned by a woman or women; or (ii) meeting all of the following 3 sub-criteria: (a) at least 20% owned by a woman or women, (b) a woman as senior or second most senior executive, and (c) at least 30% of the board members are women (where a board exists).
