The program is developed in close coordination with the key development partners and cofinanced with Agence Francaise de Developpement (AFD). The program is aligned with operational priorities 2 (accelerating gender progress), 3 (tackling climate change) and 6 (strengthening governance and institutional capacity) of ADB's Strategy 2030.
