The project is well aligned with the operational priorities of ADB's Strategy 2030. The project will help alleviate poverty by creating employment opportunities and supporting entrepreneurship (Operational Priority 1). The project will help strengthen governance and the institutional capacity of several key institutions crucial for employment creation (Operational Priority 6), and support gender equality by incorporating gender elements by providing inclusive financing and gender sensitive capacity building activities (Operational Priority 2). Moreover, in line with ADB's Strategy 2030, the project will help promote private sector development. Given the severe challenge of COVID-19, the needs by the country in all these areas take on much increased urgency and the impact of ADB support is magnified.
