The project will have the following outcome: efficiency, reliability and accessibility of urban transport services improved.
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy
Despite improvements in the quality of public transport services in Tbilisi, with new dedicated bus lanes, a modernized bus fleet and improved metro network, challenges remain. The Tbilisi City Hall (TCH) and Tbilisi Transport and Urban Development Agency (TUDA) are therefore exploring new ways of both raising revenues and reducing operational expenditures to the transit system without compromising the quality of service. Opportunities exist to generate revenues from new non-fare sources, improve operational efficiencies to reduce expenditures, and optimize business and institutional structures to incentivize subsidy reduction.
