Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy
The Republic of Uzbekistan has undergone a rapid urban and economic transformation since 2017, moving from basic infrastructure restoration to a focus on high-technology, climate-adaptive solutions for its growing population. This technical assistance (TA) will provide a programmatic approach to project preparation, moving away from isolated investments toward a coordinated sequence of projects that create synergies between physical construction and institutional reform. The TA's role is to ensure high project readiness through rigorous technical feasibility, comprehensive safeguards assessments, and advanced procurement planning. By applying consistent methodologies across sectors, the TA will build the capacity of local agencies to manage complex investment programs. The TA is included in the Uzbekistan country pipeline for 20262030.
