Summary Poverty and Social Analysis

The TA is classified as Indirect Poverty Reduction and Inclusion (IPI) because poor and vulnerable groups are not expected to be the main direct beneficiaries but may benefit indirectly through improved sector policies, institutions, and operations. The TA is expected to contribute to poverty reduction and social inclusion by strengthening gender-responsive and gender-transformative approaches in energy and transport, including through ADB-supported operations. Potential inclusion benefits may arise through improved access to safer, more affordable, and more responsive energy and transport services; expanded employment and leadership opportunities for women; and strengthened institutional capacity to address gender-related barriers in these sectors. As the TA does not include poverty-targeted interventions, direct service delivery, or transfers to poor and vulnerable groups, the IPI classification is considered appropriate.
