Project Description	The project will support procurement of safe and effective vaccines against COVID-19. The proposed Loan will be co- financed with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) under its rapid response component (RRC) of ADB's Asia Pacific Vaccine Access Facility (APVAX). <sup>1</sup> The loan proceeds of ADB and AIIB will finance expenditures in relation to the procurement of COVID-19 vaccines that meet the APVAX eligibility criteria <sup>2</sup> . The government will cover the goods and services tax for the vaccines and provide in-kind contribution, in form of counterpart staff, logistics, cold chain and various facilities to the AIIB and ADB project investment. In parallel to this Project, ADB has mobilized around USD 4 million for technical assistance <sup>3</sup> to provide catalytic operational support through program management unit, monitoring of vaccination sites, strengthening biomedical waste management capacity etc.
Objective	To vaccinate eligible populations against COVID-19 in states falling within the scope of the Project (project states) <sup>4</sup> .
Expected Results	<ul> <li>a) Vaccination of about 317 million people in target population (at least 47.5% women) against COVID-19 in the project states.</li> <li>b) About 667 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines procured and delivered to the project states.</li> </ul>

Under its SPS, ADB has categorized the project as Category C for Environment, Involuntary Resettlement, and Indigenous Peoples on the basis that no adverse ES impacts are expected. The project is proposed by ADB to be categorized as effective gender mainstreaming.
