3	Number of teachers (female and male) benefitting from training with quality standards	84,000 (24.2% male and 75.8% female)	All (84,000) DepEd and non-DepEd SHS teachers will be trained on the new grade 11 and 12 curriculum. An estimated 3,800 DepEd SHS mathematics and science teachers who cannot demonstrate subject content mastery will also receive subject content upgrading.
