#### 1. Project Information

The implementing Agency for the Renewable Energy Development & Power Sector Rehabilitation Projects is the Electric Power Corporation (the Corporation). The Electric Power Corporation is a wholly owned Government Corporation, established under the Electric Power Corporation Act 1980 with the main responsibility to generate, transmit, distribute and sell electricity as well as provide, control and maintain the use of electricity throughout Samoa.

The objective of the Renewable Energy Developments and Power Sector Rehabilitation Project (RED & PSRP) is not only to provide customer within the project area with access to higher share of electricity generated by hydropower, having reliable and affordable electricity to all its customers but also to minimize the use of fossil fuel and its impact on climate change and the climate variability in the region. The Project consists of the following;

- a) Implementation of 6.60 MW of hydropower capacity in the Project area including ;
  - i. Rehabilitating and reconnecting to the grid, three (3) small hydro plants (SHPs) on Upolu which was damaged by Cyclone Evan with a total installed capacity of 4.69MW: 1. Fale ole Fee plant (1.74MW), 2. Alaoa plant (1.05MW), 3. Samasoni plant (1.9MW), all on Upolu.
  - ii. Building and connecting to the existing grid the four (4) new small hydro plants with a combine capacity of 1.49MW: 1. Faleseela plant on Upolu (0.19MW), 2. Fausaga/Tafitoala plant (0.46MW), 3. Fuluasou plant (0.68MW) on Upolu and 4. Faleata (Vailoa Palauli) plant (0.16MW) on Savaii.
- b) Operation and Maintenance (O & M) knowledge transfer program Provision of capacity development to the EPC and knowledge transfer program provided by Consultancy Components of the turnkey Contractors including;
  - i. Preparation of (O&M) Operation & Maintenance manuals for (SHPs) small hydro plants.
  - ii. Providing theoretical and on-the-job training on hydropower assets management, which continues up to two years after commissioning.
- c) Efficient project implementation and management Assistance to the EPC through Project Owners Engineers (POE's) for efficient project implementation and management.

The Initial Subsidiary Financing Agreement for the project was signed on the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2015 between Government of Samoa and the Corporation with total funding of USD\$19.21m. During the current financial year, the European Union and the New Zealand Government have donated to the Project under the "ADB Special Operations Grant Agreement" and the revised Subsidiary Financing Agreement was amended and signed on the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2016. The local taxes and duty obligations related to the project is fully responsible by the Electric Power Corporation as per normal ADB funding requirements. The foreign grant funding sources are ADB Special Operation Grants, Disaster Response Facility (under ADB Special Funds) and Multi Donor Clean Energy Grant Funds and Government of Samoa. The financing components of the RED & PSR Project are summarized as follows;

The Corporation's contribution towards the project is also noted on section 9.01 of the Subsidiary Financing Agreement is USD\$1m from insurance compensations of three small hydro's damages during cyclone Evan.

#### 2. Statement of significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented, unless otherwise stated.

#### a. Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis unless otherwise stated. The principal accounting policies are stated to assist in a general understanding of these financial statements. The accounting basis now been adopted for this project and as recommended is Cash basis not accruals. The cash basis reflects the actual disbursements made during the period and reconciles with grants balances from time to time.

#### b. Functional and presentation currency

Items included in the financial statements of the Corporation are measured using the currency of the primary economic environment in which the entity operates (the functional currency). The functional currency is the Samoan Tala (SAT).

#### c. Foreign currency transaction

The Asian Development Bank USD equivalent rate for Samoan Tala prevailing on the date of disbursements is used for all transactions in foreign currencies.

## 3. 154.910: Implementation Consultancies

## i. Implementation Consultants

The Implementation consultancy works for Hydro Rehabilitating and Reconnecting Projects to the existing Grid was awarded to MWH NZ Limited. The contract includes both the designs and the supervisions of the rehabilitation of three small hydro stations and four new small hydro stations. The design works was completed and paid off during the period and the rest will be the supervision works

which is payable on new sites contractor mobilizations. The accumulated implementation consultant costs due and disbursed to-date contributed to 79% for the total contract amount and is fully funded by Grants. Total disbursed amount is SAT\$1,653,961.42.

ii. Project Manager

The Project Manager for the Corporation Project Management Unit (PMU) funded under PSEP Project is also managing the Renewable Energy Development & Power Sector Rehabilitation Project (RED PSRP). The project manager is in charge of organizing, planning, implementation and monitoring the Rehabilitations of three small hydro stations and the four new hydro stations yet to start. There is no cost allocation for Project Manager's role under the Project.

## 4. 154.910: Rehabilitations of three (3) Small Hydro Stations – Other Costs

This project is specifically for the refurbishment, rebuilding and reconnecting of the three small Hydro Plants which were damaged during Cyclone Evan in 2012. The project was approved and begins early 2015 with survey works, clearance, inspection and testing of damaged hydro generators of the affected small hydro plants. The following costs recorded during the period ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016.

## i. Survey works on damaged Small Hydro Plants

Surveys for three damaged Hydro Power plants were awarded as listed below;

Additional survey was carried out during the period for Alaoa and Samasoni small hydro stations on family properties and lands involved. Total additional survey cost is SAT\$4,700.00 and was funded by EPC. Total accumulated survey cost for three rehabilitation hydro is SAT\$107,010.00 and SAT\$88,965.22 was financed by ADB and SAT\$18,044.78 paid by EPC.

## ii. Maintenance and Clearance Constructions of Small Hydro Plants

The Alaoa hydro plant clearance works was awarded to Faaolataga Lawn Maintenance Service for clearance of Alaoa Headrace (Eastern canal). Contract completed in FY2014/15 with 90% of the contract price was disbursed same period. The 10% retention was released during the current financial year of SAT\$6,168.00 and contract closed. Total amount disbursed consist of SAT\$53,634.78 funded from grants and SAT\$8,045.22 paid by EPC on local taxes.

## iii. Refurbishments of Small Hydro Plants

The Hydro generators Inspection and testing contract was awarded to Pacific Engineering Projects Ltd. This is for two (2) hydro generators at Samasoni Hydro Plant and one (1) at Fale ole Fee Hydro Plant which was completed and fully paid in FY14/15 period. Total cost of this specific project in equivalent Samoan Tala is SAT\$38,005.44.

## 5. 154.910: Rehabilitations and Construction of four (4) New Small Hydro Plants

This project is specifically for the developments of four (4) new Small Hydro Plants, one (1) at Faleata (Vailoa Palauli) in Savaii and three (3) in Upolu (i) Faleseela, ii) Fuluasou & iii) Fausaga/Tafitoala. The project includes building and connecting of four (4) new hydro plants to the existing Grid. The bid evaluations has completed already and have awarded to two companies, in which the Pacific Engineering Project Limited is awarded with one (1) lot (Fuluasou Hydro Station) and the other three (3) lots awarded to Pernix MAP Limited. The constructions have not yet started but the survey works was begun from FY14/15. During the current period, couple of works was awarded to Sepulona Surveying Firm including i) face two of "Tafitoala & Fauasaga New Hydro Station and ii) Fuluasou new hydro. The Survey costs is summarized as follows;

#### 9. RED PSRP Project Subsequent Events

As at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016, the following projects have already approved and yet to award for new small hydro stations construction projects to commence the following year;

i. Rehabilitation of Fuuasou Hydro Power Station (one lot only).

This sub-project is awarded to Pacific Engineering Projects Limited and ADB approval is still pending as of year-end. There are no pending disputes on lands and properties on this site and a construction is scheduled to start the following financial year.

ii. Constructions Project of three (3) other new small hydro plants (three lots)

This sub-project is awarded to Pernix MAP Group Limited. The sub-project is a one package but contains three different lots including; i) Faleata (Vailoa) in Savaii, ii) Fausaga/Tafitoala in Upolu & iii) Faleseela in Upolu). There are land disputes on two lots (Faleata & Faleseela sites) with village councils that is still unresolved to-date. ADB has not approved the contract yet due to land disputes but EPC PMU has proposed ADB with an alternative breaking down the full contract costs by lots for assessment and to approve by lot instead. If ADB issues NOL for the 1 lot that is not disputed then to the contractor can proceed with constructions. The approvals has not yet granted as of yearend.
