Students educated and trained under improved quality assurance systems.	121,000 students of grades 10–11 (of which 60,500 or 50% are female)	This is the number of students (all non-TVET) currently enrolled at grades 10–11 during who will be using the newly developed curriculum and LTMs for grade 10 and 11 under the program.
3	Teachers trained with quality or competency standards	10,000 teachers (of which 7,500 or 75% are women)	This is the number of teachers (all non-TVET) who will be trained to use the new curriculum and LTMs developed for grades 7–11 under the program.
