Description	The proposed project will support the government's efforts to improve water supply and sanitation infrastructure and services in rural communities of Naryn Oblast, the Kyrgyz Republic. The indicative program scope will include: (i) development and rehabilitation of water supply networks and related infrastructure; (ii) piloting of non-networked sanitation solutions; and (iii) establishment of sustainable operational models, including development of local professional and vocational capacity and community-based operational management.		
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	The Drinking Water Supply, Wastewater Disposal and Sanitation Strategy until Republic has set ambitious targets for increasing access to potable water suppl sanitation. In rural areas, the goal is to reach 90% coverage for water services sanitation systems by 2026. A countrywide assessment indicates that 651 out or require new water supply systems, while 760 villages require substantial invest rehabilitation and expansion. Investment needs were estimated to be \$600 mil alone.
