## Consulting Services

ADB will engage the consultants following the ADB Procurement Policy (2017, as amended from time to time) and its associated project administration instructions and/or staff instructions. TA implementation will be carried out through 200 person-months of consulting inputs, consisting of (i) a technical advisory and monitoring consulting firm totaling 108 person-months of consulting inputs; (ii) an assessment specialist consulting firm totaling 12 person-months of consulting inputs; (iii) an impact evaluation design consulting firm totaling 8 person-months; (iv) 8 individual consultants and a pool of resource persons totaling 72 person-months (15 person-months of international and 57 person-months of national inputs). Consulting firms will be recruited through open competitive bidding procedures, local advertisement, and/or limited competitive bidding using the quality- and cost-based selection method, requiring a simplified technical proposal or biodata technical proposal. Other selection methods such as consultants' qualification-based selection and single source selection may be used, as any proposal or biodata technical proposal.
