The program will address the following root cause the challenges identified: (i) the absence of sector overarching strategic or legal and regulatory frameworks; (ii) legacy indebtedness and zero fiscal support for loss-making passenger services or the operation and maintenance cost of strategic assets; (iii) operationa inefficiencies and a legacy surplus workforce; and (iv) lack of transport policies that provide equal treatment of rail and road freight. The program will be aligned with the following overarching country development objective: strengthen public finance management a increase economic growth.
