1. The Government of South Sudan has received a Grant from the African Development Fund to finance the Resilient Water Project for Improved Livelihoods in Juba.
2. The principal objective of this project is to improve water supply infrastructure and contribute to improved livelihoods of people in Juba city.
3. The project includes the following components:

No	Component	Component Description
1	<b>Institution strengthening and Capacity Development</b>	This component will ensure sustainability of the installed infrastructure and will support SSUWC in strengthening institutional capacity; improving financial sustainability and commercial operations; and addressing technical and environmental sustainability.
2	<b>Water Supply Infrastructure Development</b>	This component will address the infrastructure improvement needs on the distribution network, distribution outlets, metering and replacing sections of the old Juba water treatment plant including the consultancy services for design and contract supervision of water works.
3	<b>Project Management</b>	This component comprises services and activities related to project management and operations for smooth implementation of the project.

4. Procurement of goods, works and services will be in accordance with the Bank's Procurement Policy for Bank Group Funded Operations dated October 2015. Bidding and Request for Proposal documents are expected to be available in April 2017.
