Description

The project will adopt an integrated approach to address Tripura's urban infrastructure and service delivery constraints by expanding water supply systems, improving stormwater drainage, enhancing urban roads and connectivity, and upgrading tourism infrastructure and public amenities, supported by improved system monitoring and institutional strengthening. These interventions will enable more reliable and continuous water supply, reduce flooding risks, improve urban mobility and livability, and strengthen tourism-driven economic development. By addressing service gaps across the remaining ULBs and critical infrastructure bottlenecks in Agartala, the project will help align urban services provision with the state's growing economic potential and increasing tourism demand.

Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy
ADB will bring value addition through financing of integrated and climate-resilient urban services in Agartala and the remaining underserved ULBs, with a focus on water supply, sewerage and stormwater drainage, while also supporting tourism infrastructure and connectivity. It will enhance tourismurban linkages through improved connectivity, sanitation, and visitor amenities, and build institutional capacity in asset management, operations and maintenance, and climate and disaster risk management. In doing so, the project will position Agartala as a more resilient and competitive border city within the North East Economic Corridor, while supporting more balanced and inclusive urban development across Tripura.

Building on ADB's ongoing supports, the proposed project will scale up integrated investments across remaining underserved ULBs and address system-level gaps in Agartala.
