The planned civil works under the tranche will affect 788.8 acres. 1,961 households will face loss of their assets including ded land and assets established within the encroached ROWs limits, and 987 displaced households (12 in land loss category and 975 facing loss of eir commercial assets established in the ROW) will face 10% or more loss of their productive assets (land and commercial assets).
