Description	The additional financing of Infrastructure Preparation and Innovation Facility Project (IPIF) will extend the support of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to the Government of the Philippines under the current project to meet the government's accelerated infrastructure development objectives. The additional financing, together with the current project, will support project preparation and improve the infrastructure project management capacity of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH). The project will build on the current project to (i) improve the quality of priority infrastructure project proposals for approval by the Investment Coordination Committee (ICC) of the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA); (ii) accelerate early project implementation following ICC approval through detailed engineering design (DED) and tendering support, with a focus on complex and large projects requiring international expertise; and (iii) strengthen the government's capacity to implement projects under the DOTr and DPWH.		
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	Foreseeing that the demand for project preparation activities will exceed current IPIF funding, the government, through the Infrastructure Preparation and Innovation Facility Project (IPIF) steering committee during a meeting on 1 March 2019, indicated that ADB should provide an additional financing to scale up IPIF. The additional financing of IPIF will finance project readiness activities for large projects and build capacity in agencies to implement them. The additional financing will, among others, extend IPIF assistance by bringing selected flagship projects initiated under IPIF until the stage when civil works can commence. Particularly, it will finance the detailed engineering design for projects with ongoing feasibility study under IPIF, e.g. the Bataan-Cavite Link Bridge Project, and the Laguna Lakeshore Road Network Project.The IPIF and additional financing of IPIF will prepare several large priority projects for which the government is considering ADB financing for the civil works.
