(First Programmatic Shared Prosperity Development Policy Loan)

between

**REPUBLIC OF PANAMA** 

and

INTERNATIONAL BANK FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT

Dated May 27, 2015



#### LOAN AGREEMENT

## ARTICLE I — GENERAL CONDITIONS; DEFINITIONS

- 1.01. The General Conditions (as defined in the Appendix to this Agreement) constitute an integral part of this Agreement.
- 1.02. Unless the context requires otherwise, the capitalized terms used in this Agreement have the meanings ascribed to them in the General Conditions or in the Appendix to this Agreement.

#### ARTICLE II — LOAN

- 2.01. The Bank agrees to lend to the Borrower, on the terms and conditions set forth or referred to in this Agreement, the amount of three hundred million Dollars (US\$300,000,000), as such amount may be converted from time to time through a Currency Conversion in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.08 of this Agreement ("Loan").
- 2.02. The Borrower may withdraw the proceeds of the Loan in support of the Program in accordance with Section II of Schedule 1 to this Agreement.
- 2.03. The Front-end Fee payable by the Borrower shall be equal to one quarter of one percent (0.25%), of the Loan amount. The Borrower shall pay the Front-end Fee not later than sixty (60) days after the Effective Date.
- 2.04. The Commitment Charge payable by the Borrower shall be equal to one quarter of one percent (0.25%) per annum on the Unwithdrawn Loan Balance.
- 2.05. The interest payable by the Borrower for each Interest Period shall be at a rate equal to the Reference Rate for the Loan Currency plus the Variable Spread; provided, that upon a Conversion of all or any portion of the principal amount of the Loan, the interest payable by the Borrower during the Conversion Period on such amount shall be determined in accordance with the relevant provisions of Article IV of the General Conditions. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if any amount of the Withdrawn Loan Balance remains unpaid when due and such non-payment continues for a period of thirty (30) days, then the interest payable by the Borrower shall instead be calculated as provided in Section 3.02 (e) of the General Conditions.
- 2.06. The Payment Dates are February 1 and August 1 in each year.

- 2.07. The principal amount of the Loan shall be repaid in accordance with the amortization schedule set forth in Schedule 2 to this Agreement.
- 2.08. The Borrower may at any time request any of the following Conversions of the (a) terms of the Loan in order to facilitate prudent debt management: (i) a change of the Loan Currency of all or any portion of the principal amount of the Loan. withdrawn or unwithdrawn, to an Approved Currency; (ii) a change of the interest rate basis applicable to: (A) all or any portion of the principal amount of the Lc 11 withdrawn and outstanding from a Variable Rate to a Fixed Rate, or vice versa; or (B) all or any portion of the principal amount of the Loan withdrawn and outstanding from a Variable Rate based on a Reference Rate and the Varial I: Spread to a Variable Rate based on a Fixed Reference Rate and the Varial I: Spread, or vice versa; or (C) all of the principal amount of the Loan withdrawn and outstanding from a Variable Rate based on a Variable Spread to a Variable Rate based on a Fixed Spread; and (iii) the setting of limits on the Variable Rate or 11: Reference Rate applicable to all or any portion of the principal amount of the Le 11 withdrawn and outstanding by the establishment of an Interest Rate Cap or Interest Rate Collar on the Variable Rate or the Reference Rate.
  - (b) Any conversion requested pursuant to paragraph (a) of this Section that is accepted by the Bank shall be considered a "Conversion", as defined in the General Conditions, and shall be effected in accordance with the provisions of Article V of the General Conditions and of the Conversion Guidelines.
- 2.09. Without limitation upon the provisions of Section 5.08 of the General Conditions (renumbered as such pursuant to paragraph 3 of Section II of the Appendix to this Agreement and relating to Cooperation and Consultation), the Borrower shall promp by furnish to the Bank such information relating to the provisions of this Article II as the Bank may, from time to time, reasonably request.

## ARTICLE III — PROGRAM

- 3.01. The Borrower declares its commitment to the Program and its implementation. To t its end, and further to Section 5.08 of the General Conditions:
  - (a) the Borrower and the Bank shall from time to time, at the request of either par y, exchange views on the Borrower's macroeconomic policy framework and 1 12 progress achieved in carrying out the Program;
  - (b) prior to each such exchange of views, the Borrower shall furnish to the Bank its review and comment a report on the progress achieved in carrying out the Program, in such detail as the Bank shall reasonably request; and
  - without limitation upon the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of this Sections, the Borrower shall promptly inform the Bank of any situation that would have the effect of materially reversing the objectives of the Program or any action takes under the Program including any action specified in Section I of Schedule 1 to this Agreement.

#### ARTICLE IV — REMEDIES OF THE BANK

4.01. The Additional Events of Suspension consist of the following, namely that a situation has arisen which shall make it improbable that the Program, or a significant part of it, will be carried out.

#### ARTICLE V — EFFECTIVENESS; TERMINATION

- 5.01. The Additional Condition of Effectiveness consists of the following, namely that the Bank is satisfied with the progress achieved by the Borrower in carrying out the Program and with the adequacy of the Borrower's macroeconomic policy framework.
- 5.02. The Effectiveness Deadline is the date ninety (90) days after the date of this Agreement.

# ARTICLE VI — REPRESENTATIVE; ADDRESSES

- 6.01. The Borrower's Representative is its Minister of Economy and Finance.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

#### Program Actions; Availability of Loan Proceeds

## Section I. Actions under the Program

The actions taken by the Borrower under the Program include the following:

#### Pillar 1: Expanding Inclusion and Opportunities

- 1. The Borrower has increased payment incentives to the beneficiaries of the *Beca Universal* program, differentiated by schooling level (*primaria*, *pre-media*, *media* cycles) pursuant to Law No. 14 dated August 14, 2014 and published in the Borrower's Official Gazette on even date.
- 2. The Borrower has: (a) piloted the "Programa Panamá Pro-Joven", a vocational training program that provides on the job training to graduates of the technical branch of secondary education, pursuant to the Cooperation and Coordination Agreement between MITRADEL and MEDUCA on October 1, 2014; and (b) legally created a new set of baccalaureates, as part of a curricula consistent with labor market demands, pursuant to the Borrower's Executive Decree No. 21 dated January 31, 2014 and published in the Official Gazette on February 05, 2014.
- 3. The Borrower has expanded the coverage and benefits of the "*Programa 120 a los 65*", the social protection program for the elderly without pension to provide 120 Balboas monthly, pursuant to the Borrower's Law No. 15 dated September 1, 2014 and published in the Official Gazette on even date.

## Pillar 2: Improving Service Delivery

- 4. The Borrower has: (a) created the "Unidad Gestora de Agua y Saneamiento", a management unit within the "Secretaría de Metas Presidenciales" to carry out the "Plan de Sanidad Básica 100/0", a basic sanitation plan to provide 100 percent access to drinking water and 0 latrines, pursuant to the Borrower's Executive Decree No. 1221 dated July 2, 2014 and published on the Official Gazette on July 3, 2014; and (b) launched the SIASAR, a standardized information system for improving the monitoring of water management in rural areas, pursuant to the "Regional Agreement to Adopt the Methodology, Processes and Regulations applicable for SIASAR" signed by the Borrower and other Central American countries on April 1, 2014.
- 5. The Borrower has: (a) approved the adjustment of electricity tariff subsidies pursuant to the Borrower's Cabinet Resolution No. 177 dated December 2, 2014 and published on the Official Gazette on December 9, 2014; and (b) established a regime of incentives to increase the share of renewable energy in the power generation matrix pursuant to the Borrower's Law No 37 dated June 10, 2013 and published on the Official Gazette on June 13, 2013.

#### Pillar 3: Modernizing Fiscal Management

- 6. The Borrower has: (a) approved the introduction of the single treasury account; and (b) channeled all funds of the treasury and MEF through the single treasury account pursua at to the Borrower's Law No. 56 dated September 17, 2013, published in the Official Gaze to on September 18, 2013 and Law No. 19, dated September 30, 2014 and published in the Official Gazette on October 1, 2014, respectively.
- 7. The Borrower has approved a policy for managing fiscal risks related to natural disasters which includes the identification and evaluation of fiscal risk from disasters, the integration of disaster risk analysis into public investment planning, and the design of risk retention and risk transfer tools, pursuant to the Borrower's Executive Decree No. 578 dated November 13, 2014 and published in the Official Gazette on November 18, 2014.

## Section II. Availability of I oan Proceeds

- A. General. The Borrower may withdraw the proceeds of the Loan in accordance with the provisions of this Section and such additional instructions as the Bank may specify motice to the Borrower.
- **B.** Allocation of Loan Amounts. The Loan is allocated in a single withdrawal tranche, from which the Borrower may make withdrawals of the Loan proceeds. The allocation of the amounts of the Loan to this end is set out in the table below:

- C. Payment of Front-end Fee. No withdrawal shall be made from the Loan Account ur ii the Bank has received payment in full of the Front-end Fee.
- **D.** Withdrawal Tranche Release Conditions. No withdrawal shall be made of the Single Withdrawal Tranche unless the Bank is satisfied: (a) with the Program being carried out my the Borrower; and (b) with the adequacy of the Borrower's macroeconomic policy framework.
- **E. Deposits of Loan Amounts.** Except as the Bank may otherwise agree:
- 1. all withdrawals from the Loan Account shall be deposited by the Bank into an account designated by the Borrower and acceptable to the Bank; and

- 2. the Borrower shall ensure that upon each deposit of an amount of the Loan into this account, an equivalent amount is accounted for in the Borrower's budget management system, in a manner acceptable to the Bank.
- **Excluded Expenditures.** The Borrower undertakes that the proceeds of the Loan shall not be used to finance Excluded Expenditures. If the Bank determines at any time that an amount of the Loan was used to make a payment for an Excluded Expenditure, the Borrower shall, promptly upon notice from the Bank, refund an amount equal to the amount of such payment to the Bank. Amounts refunded to the Bank upon such request shall be cancelled.
- G. Closing Date. The Closing Date is April 30, 2016.

#### **SCHEDULE 2**

## **Amortization Schedule**

1. The following table sets forth the Principal Payment Dates of the Loan and the percentage of the total principal amount of the Loan payable on each Principal Payment Date ("Installment Share"). If the proceeds of the Loan have been fully withdrawn as of the first Principal Payment Date, the principal amount of the Loan repayable by the Borrower of each Principal Payment Date shall be determined by the Bank by multiplying:

Withdrawn Loan Balance as of the first Principal Payment Date; by (b) the Installment Share for each Principal Payment Date, such repayable amount to be adjusted, as necessary, to deduct any amounts referred to in paragraph 4 of this Schedule, to which a Currer Conversion applies.

- 2. If the proceeds of the Loan have not been fully withdrawn as of the first Principal Payment Date, the principal amount of the Loan repayable by the Borrower on each Principal Payment Date shall be determined as follows:
  - (a) To the extent that any proceeds of the Loan have been withdrawn as of the first Principal Payment Date, the Borrower shall repay the Withdrawn Loan Balance as of such date in accordance with paragraph 1 of this Schedule.
  - (b) Any amount withdrawn after the first Principal Payment Date shall be repaid of each Principal Payment Date falling after the date of such withdrawal in amounts determined by the Bank by multiplying the amount of each such withdrawal by a fraction, the numerator of which is the original Installment Share specified in the table in paragraph 1 of this Schedule for said Principal Payment Date ("Original Installment Share") and the denominator of which is the sum of all remaining Original Installment Shares for Principal Payment Dates falling on or after such date, such amounts repayable to be adjusted, as necessary, to deduct any amounts referred to in paragraph 4 of this Schedule, to which a Currency Conversion applies.
- 3. (a) Amounts of the Loan withdrawn within two calendar months prior to any Princip el Payment Date shall, for the purposes solely of calculating the principal amounts payable on any Frincipal Payment Date, be treated as withdrawn and outstanding on the second Principal Payment Date following the date of withdrawal and shall be repayable on each Principal Payment Date commencing with the second Principal Payment Date following the date of withdrawal.
  - (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph, if at a 1/2 time the Bank adopts a due date billing system under which invoices are issued > 1

or after the respective Principal Payment Date, the provisions of such subparagraph shall no longer apply to any withdrawals made after the adoption of such billing system.

- 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Schedule, upon a Currency Conversion of all or any portion of the Withdrawn Loan Balance to an Approved Currency, the amount so converted in the Approved Currency that is repayable on any Principal Payment Date occurring during the Conversion Period, shall be determined by the Bank by multiplying such amount in its currency of denomination immediately prior to the Conversion by either: (a) the exchange rate that reflects the amounts of principal in the Approved Currency payable by the Bank under the Currency Hedge Transaction relating to the Conversion; or (b) if the Bank so determines in accordance with the Conversion Guidelines, the exchange rate component of the Screen Rate.
- 5. If the Withdrawn Loan Balance is denominated in more than one Loan Currency, the provisions of this Schedule shall apply separately to the amount denominated in each Loan Currency, so as to produce a separate amortization schedule for each such amount.

#### **APPENDIX**

## Section I. <u>Definitions</u>

- 1. "Beca Universal" means the Borrower's program established pursuant to Law No. 8 a 13 Law No. 40 of 2010, and their modifications, which provides financial support to stude its from primaria, pre-media and media, as incentives, until the culmination of their studies
- 2. "Excluded Expenditure" means any expenditure:
  - (a) for goods or services supplied under a contract which any national or international financing institution or agency other than the Bank or the Association has financed or agreed to finance, or which the Bank or the Association has financed or agreed to finance under another loan, credit, or grant;
  - (b) for goods included in the following groups or sub-groups of the Standard International Trade Classification, Revision 3 (SITC, Rev.3), published by the United Nations in Statistical Papers, Series M, No. 34/Rev.3 (1986) (the SITC), or any successor groups or subgroups under future revisions to the SITC, as designated by the Bank by notice to the Borrower:

- (c) for goods intended for a military or paramilitary purpose or for luxury consumption;
- (d) for environmentally hazardous goods, the manufacture, use or import of which is prohibited under the laws of the Borrower or international agreements to which the Borrower is a party;
- (e) on account of any payment prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations; and
- (f) with respect to which the Bank determines that corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices were engaged in by representatives of the Borrower or other recipient of the Loan proceeds, without the Borrower (or other such recipient) having taken timely and appropriate action satisfactory to the Bank to address such practices when they occur.
- 3. "General Conditions" means the "International Bank for Reconstruction and Development General Conditions for Loans", dated March 12, 2012 with the modifications set forth in Section II of this Appendix.
- 4. "MEDUCA" means *Ministerio de Educación*, the Borrower's Ministry of Education.
- 5. "MEF" means *Ministerio de Economía y Finanzas*, the Borrower's Ministry of Economy and Finance.
- 6. "MIDES" means *Ministerio de Desarrollo Social*, the Borrower's Ministry of Social Development.
- 7. "MINSA" means *Ministerio de Salud*, the Borrower's Ministry of Health.
- 8. "MITRADEL" means *Ministerio de Trabajo y Desarrollo Laboral*, the Borrower's Ministry of Labor and Employment.
- 9. "Program" means the program of actions, objectives and policies designed to promote growth and achieve sustainable reductions in poverty and set forth or referred to in the letter dated January 19, 2015, from the Borrower to the Bank declaring the Borrower's commitment to the execution of the Program, and requesting assistance from the Bank in support of the Program during its execution.
- 10. "Programa Panamá Pro-Joven" means the Borrower's program established by the MITRADEL and MEDUCA, which provides on the job training to Panamanian youth aiming to improve their effective insertion in the labor market.
- 11. "Programa 100/0" means the Borrower's sanitation plan that aims to provide water services 24 hours per day and to eliminate latrines across the country, to be implemented by the Unidad Gestora de Agua y Saneamiento, under the Secretaría de Metas Presidenciales.

- 12. "Programa 120 a los 65" means the Borrower's social program (originally denominated "Programa 100 a los 70") established pursuant Law No. 86 of 2010 which provides financial monthly support to the elderly without pension.
- 13. "SIASAR" means the Sistema de Información de Agua y Saneamiento Rural, a regiol el platform adopted by several countries in Central America, to facilitate the harmonization and exchange of information regarding the water and sanitation systems with particu as focus on rural areas.
- 14. "Single Withdrawal Tranche" means the amount of the Loan allocated to the category entitled "Single Withdrawal Tranche" in the table set forth in Part B of Section II of Schedule 1 to this Agreement.

# Section II. Modifications to the General Conditions

The General Conditions are hereby modified as follows:

- 1. In the **Table of Contents**, the references to Sections, Section names and Section numbers are modified to reflect the modifications set forth in the paragraphs below.
- 2. The last sentence of paragraph (a) of Section 2.03 (relating to Applications for Withdraw II) is deleted in its entirety.
- 3. Sections 2.04 (*Designated Accounts*) and 2.05 (*Eligible Expenditures*) are deleted in their entirety, and the remaining Sections in Article II are renumbered accordingly.
- 4. Section 3.01. (Front-end Fee) is modified to read as follows:
  - "Section 3.01. Front-end Fee; Commitment Charge
  - (a) The Borrower shall pay the Bank a front-end fee on the Loan amount at the rate specified in the Loan Agreement (the "Front-end Fee").
  - (b) The Borrower shall pay the Bank a commitment charge on the Unwithdrawn Lc 11 Balance at the rate specified in the Loan Agreement (the "Commitment Charge"). The Commitment Charge shall accrue from a date sixty (60) days after the date of the Lc 11 Agreement to the respective dates on which amounts are withdrawn by the Borrower from the Loan Account or cancelled. The Commitment Charge shall be payable semi-annually in arrears on each Payment Date."
- 5. Sections 5.01 (*Project Execution Generally*), and 5.09 (*Financial Management; Financ of Statements; Audits*) are deleted in their entirety, and the subsequent Sections in Article V are renumbered accordingly.
- 6. Paragraph (a) of Section 5.05 (renumbered as such pursuant to paragraph 5 above and relating to *Use of Goods, Works and Services*) is deleted in its entirety.

7. Paragraph (c) of Section 5.06 (renumbered as such pursuant to paragraph 5 above) is modified to read as follows:

"Section 5.06. Plans; Documents; Records

- ... (c) The Borrower shall retain all records (contracts, orders, invoices, bills, receipts and other documents) evidencing expenditures under the Loan until two years after the Closing Date. The Borrower shall enable the Bank's representatives to examine such records."
- 8. Paragraph (c) of Section 5.07 (renumbered as such pursuant to paragraph 5 above) is modified to read as follows:

# "Section 5.07. Program Monitoring and Evaluation

- ... (c) The Borrower shall prepare, or cause to be prepared, and furnish to the Bank not later than six (6) months after the Closing Date, a report of such scope and in such detail as the Bank shall reasonably request, on the execution of the Program, the performance by the Loan Parties and the Bank of their respective obligations under the Legal Agreements and the accomplishment of the purposes of the Loan."
- 9. In the Appendix, **Definitions**, all references to Section numbers and paragraphs are modified, as necessary, to reflect the modifications set forth above.
- 10. The Appendix is modified by inserting a new paragraph 19 with the following definition of "Commitment Charge", and renumbering the remaining paragraphs accordingly:
  - "19. "Commitment Charge" means the commitment charge specified in the Loan Agreement for the purpose of Section 3.01(b)."
- 11. Renumbered paragraph 37 (originally paragraph 36) of the Appendix ("Eligible Expenditure") is modified to read as follows:
  - "37. "Eligible Expenditure" means any use to which the Loan is put in support of the Program, other than to finance expenditures excluded pursuant to the Loan Agreement."
- 12. Renumbered paragraph 44 (originally paragraph 43) of the Appendix ("Financial Statements") is deleted in its entirety.
- 13. In paragraph 48 of the Appendix, the definition of "Front-end Fee" is modified by replacing the reference to Section 3.01 with Section 3.01 (a).
- 14. In paragraph 67 of the Appendix, the definition of the term "Loan Payment" is modified to read as follows:
  - "67. "Loan Payment" means any amount payable by the Loan Parties to the Bank pursuant to the Legal Agreements or these General Conditions, including (but not limited to) any amount of the Withdrawn Loan Balance, interest, the Front-end Fee, the Commitment Charge, interest at the Default Interest Rate (if any), any prepayment

premium, any transaction fee for a Conversion or early termination of a Conversion, the Variable Spread Fixing Charge (if any), any premium payable upon the establishment of an Interest Rate Cap or Interest Rate Collar, and any Unwinding Amount payable by the Borrower."

- 15. In paragraph 72 of the Appendix, the definition of "Payment Date" is modified by deleting the word "is" and inserting the words "and Commitment Charge are" after the word "interest".
- 16. The defined term "Project" in paragraph 75 of the Appendix is modified to read "Program" and its definition is modified to read as follows (and all references to "Project" through the three General Conditions are deemed to be references to "Program"):
  - "75. "Program" means the program referred to in the Loan Agreement in support of which the Loan is made."
