

GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

Strengthening Institutions of Transparency and Accountability (SITA) Project

1. The Parliament of Zimbabwe and the Office of the Auditor General have received a grant from the African Development Bank to finance the Strengthening of Institutions of Transparency and Accountability Project.
2. The main objectives this project is to improve institutional capacity and effectiveness of institutions of public oversight and accountability. The project will involve procurement of goods (i.e. the supply of IT and Office furniture to be procured using National Competitive Bidding and Shopping); and consulting services which will be procured competitively by shortlisting of consulting firms using Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS), Least Cost Selection (LCS) and shortlisting of Individual Consultants.
3. The project has three components: (i) improved capacity and effectiveness of Parliament; (ii) enhanced capacity and effectiveness of the Office of Auditor General; and (iii) Project management support. The major activities include support to: (a) establish a Parliamentary Budget Office; (b) Parliamentary Committees; (c) Women Parliamentary Caucus to foster gender equality; (d) enhancing demand-side of accountability through partnership with key local organisations; (e) the Office of the Auditor General to improve public finance oversight and accountability; and (f) project management support.
4. Procurement of Goods will be in accordance with the African Development Bank's (AfDB) Rules of Procedures for the Procurement of Goods and Works (May 2008 Edition, revised July 2012). Acquisition of the services of consultants will follow the AfDB's Rules of Procedures for the Use of Consultants (May 2008 Edition, revised July 2012). Bidding documents are expected to be available starting from November 2015.
