Brief description of the program objectives and components:

The purpose of the program is to achieve a sustainable increase in the coverage and quality of the rural economic infrastructure and food and agriculture services. The program includes two major lines of financing for: (1) infrastructure and service areas to support projects for: rural roads, electrification and other sources of rural energy, irrigation and drainage, and various services to support food and agriculture production; and (2) business areas to encourage developing initiatives for agricultural clusters and investments in food and agriculture supply chains.

1. Infrastructure and services

The objective is to help increase the coverage and quality of infrastructure and services for the rural population in the provinces. Projects financed will include rural energy, roads, and irrigation and drainage infrastructure. In all cases, along with investments to increase efficiency in the use of services, users will be encouraged to participate through associative arrangements that allow the private sector to help operate and maintain the systems.

For food and agriculture services, projects will be financed in areas such as: (i) technological development; (ii) agricultural health and quality; (iii) commercial development; (iv) land titling and tenure regularization; (v) information technology and rural connectivity; and (vi) strengthening of provincial institutional capacity.

Brief description of the program objectives and components (cont.):

2. Rural food and agriculture businesses

a) Cluster development initiatives

This area will finance agribusiness cluster and service projects to enhance the competitiveness of productive activities concentrated within a specific geographic area. To achieve this objective, efforts will be made to facilitate access by enterprises to new markets, take advantage of economies of scale, where feasible, encourage innovation and the transfer of technology, improve business strategies, improve quality and productivity, and, in general, eliminate barriers identified to enhance regional competitiveness where those clusters are located.

b) Promotion of investments in supply chains

This area of intervention will finance projects that permit the integration of small and medium-sized producers and micro, small, and medium-sized agribusiness enterprises and service providers into food and agriculture chains. The initiatives are to be presented as business plans, which may have different characteristics based on the problems or "bottlenecks" that hinder the competitiveness of producers. The beneficiaries cofinance strategic investments and the program grants nonreimbursable contributions (NRCs).

II. INTRODUCTION

Procurement for the proposed program will be in accordance with the "Policies for the procurement of works and goods financed by the IDB" (document GN-2349-7) of July 2006, and the "Policies for selection and contracting of consultants financed by the IDB" (document GN-2350-7) of July 2006, and with the provisions of the loan contract and this procurement plan.

III. PROCUREMENT PLAN

The procurement plan for the Provincial Agricultural Services Program II (PROSAP II), which covers the first 18 months of the program, has been agreed by the Bank and SAGPyA. For each contract or group of contracts, the plan, which is summarized in Appendix 1, indicates the procedure for procuring goods, works, or services, or consultant selection methods, cases that require prequalification, the estimated costs of each contract or group of contracts, the requirement for ex ante or ex post reviews by the Bank, and the estimated dates of publication of the specific procurement notices and expiration of the contracts corresponding to this program. The procurement plan will be updated annually, or when necessary or required by the Bank. The detailed procurement plan will be available at SAGPyA and www.prosap.gov.ar. It is also found on the Bank's website: Project procurement information.

IV. PROGRAM PROCUREMENT

Following is a general description of works and goods to be procured for the proposed program.

A. Works

Works to be procured include:

- a. Construction of civil and electromechanical works and functional tests
- b. Electrification works
- c. Rural road improvement works
- d. Rural electrification works
- e. Irrigation works
- f. Soil conservation works

Procurement of works for the program by international competitive bidding (ICB) will use the Bank's standard bidding documents. Procurement by national competitive bidding (NCB) will use the national bidding documents agreed with the Bank.

B. Goods

Goods to be procured for this program include vehicles, machinery, computer and communications equipment, electrical equipment, mechanical equipment, materials and inputs, tools, and measurement instruments.

Procurement of goods for the project by ICB will use the Bank's standard bidding documents. Procurement by NCB will use the national bidding documents agreed with the Bank. Shopping and, where appropriate, direct contracting will be used in accordance with paragraphs 3.5 and 3.6, respectively, of document GN-2349-7.

C. Procurement of nonconsulting services

D. Procurement of consulting services

Consulting services under the program include: national individual consulting services, national consulting firms, individual consulting services from international experts, engineering studies, and supervision of works.

Consulting firms will be selected for the program using the standard Request for Proposal (RFP) document issued by the Bank or an RFP that is satisfactory to the Bank if the standard RFP is not applicable. Individual consultants will be selected with consideration for the provisions of Chapter V of the policy set forth in document GN-2350-7.

V. BANK REVIEW OF PROCUREMENT DECISIONS

The following contracts will be subject to ex ante review by the Bank in accordance with Appendix 1 of the policies on procurement of goods and services and selection of consultants, respectively:

F. Goods, works, and nonconsulting services

Threshold for ex ante review: Initially, all procurement will be reviewed ex ante. Twelve months after the date of the first purchase or contract, if the Bank determines based on periodic reviews, external audit reports of the program's financial statements, and inspection visits that internal controls are effective, the Bank may elect to perform ex post reviews of procurement and disbursement processes, provided the amounts of the goods and works procured are below the ICB thresholds. The Bank may at any time partially or fully revoke the right to procure goods, works, and services under the ex post review modality. As a result of the findings from ex post reviews, and based on the circumstances, the Bank may reject financing with resources from the Bank loan as well as against the counterpart contribution.

Prequalification: There will be no prequalification.

G. Selection of consulting firms

Threshold for ex ante review: Initially, all procurement will be reviewed ex ante. Twelve months after the date of execution of the first contract, if the Bank determines based on periodic reviews and external audit reports of the program's financial statements that internal controls are effective, the Bank may elect to perform ex post reviews of procurement and disbursement processes, provided the consulting assignments are valued at less than US\$200,000 for consulting firms and US\$50,000 for individual consultants. The Bank may at any time partially or fully revoke the right to procure goods, works, and services under the ex post review modality. As a result of the findings from ex post reviews, and based on the circumstances, the Bank may reject financing with resources from the Bank loan as well as against the counterpart contribution.

Shortlist comprised entirely of national consultants: The shortlist for consulting services valued at less than US\$500,000 per contract may be comprised entirely of national consultants.

VI. DOMESTIC PREFERENCE

Bids offering goods from the country of the borrower will be granted a margin of preference equivalent to 15% in contracts awarded by ICB, in accordance with the provisions of Appendix 2 of the procurement policies.
