Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project closing date has been extended by a year until July 15, 2017. This has been done to enable the government completing project activities. The activities were severely disrupted due to the unofficial trade blockades along the Nepal-India borders. Also the project faced post-earthquake uncertainties after the end-April, 2015 devastating earthquake and aftershocks. Now the project has turned the corner and the pace of implementation has improved substantially.

The project's mid-term review, generally conducted at the mid-point of project's life, was conducted in early-August, 2016. The review has concluded that the project would likely to achieve all two project development objective indicators. However, the review has assessed that one of the three intermediate outcome indicators (establishment of a dedicated unit for managing road safety) might not be achieved. Also the review has called for expediting the pace of implementation of the five contracts linked to the installation of crash barriers (thee) and pilot road safety activities in Pokhara and adjoining highway (Siddhartha Highway).

The pace of implementation of the crash barrier installation and pilot road safety activity contracts has increased recently – especially the Pokhara urban pilot contract, which was non-performing one at the time of the mid-term review. Remaining Component A activities (capacity strengthening for the implementation of road safety action plan) have now been progressing well. Most of them are expected to be completed by March, 2017. The World Bank team is working closely with the government in order to complete all planned activities within the project period. If the project objectives are achieved, which is most likely, it will usher in a new era in road safety in Nepal.
