### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project has started in the aftermath of the April, 2015 earthquake. The post-earthquake instability and the unofficial trade blockades have hampered its progress severely. An extension of the project closing date is required in order to achieve its objectives. The government has already requested the World Bank for an extension of the project period: from mid-July, 2016 to mid-July, 2017.

The project has made significant progress in recent months. All physical work contracts are procured and contractors have mobilized. All consultancy contracts are also procured. Most consultants have started their inputs. The government needs to make immediate progress on the establishment of the Nepal Road Safety Council.


