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I. BACKGROUND

1. The transaction technical assistance (TA) cluster was approved on 8 April 2020 in the amount of \$3,000,000 which is being financed on a grant basis by the Asian Development Bank's (ADB) Technical Assistance Special Fund (TASF) and is expected to be completed on 31 December 2022.¹ The overall outcome of the TA cluster is gender mainstreaming in Central and West Asia operations expanded and improved. The outputs are (i) gender-inclusive components in sovereign projects and programs incorporated; and (ii) developing member countries' capacity for gender action plan implementation and monitoring of gender equality results enhanced. There are twelve subprojects in the TA cluster. Each subproject will contribute to deliver the gender outputs of the ensuing loan that it will support, and this will be specified in each subproject proposal. The TA cluster's risk categorization is complex.

2. Of the twelve subprojects in the TA cluster, four subprojects are ongoing while one subproject is completed (Appendix 2). Six subprojects will be processed and implemented following the processing milestones of the respective loan/grant projects that the subprojects will support. One of the subprojects will support integration of gender in all projects and monitor the implementation of project gender action plans. As of 22 September 2021, a total of \$1,500,000 representing 50% of the total TA cluster amount has been committed, of which \$407,187 or 27.1% has been disbursed.² Total uncommitted funds stand at \$1,500,000 which will be utilized for the remaining subprojects to be processed.

II. THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE SUBPROJECT

A. Subproject Scope

3. The Central and West Asia Department (CWRD) continuously strives to increase the number of gender mainstreamed projects in its portfolio, especially in the more challenging sectors of energy, finance, governance, and transport. As of 3 September 2021, the CWRD portfolio includes 142 projects supporting gender mainstreaming, of which 72 projects are categorized as gender equity theme (GEN) and effective gender mainstreaming (EGM).³ The GEN/EGM-categorized projects include 6 energy projects (8%), 7 finance projects (10%), 3 public sector management projects (4%), and 11 transport projects (15%).⁴ Of the other GEN/EGM categorized projects, water and other urban services projects comprise 22%, agriculture projects constitute 17%, and projects in the health and education sectors comprise 14% and 10%, respectively. CWRD's gender mainstreaming performance at-entry has risen substantially from 51% in 2019 to 81% in 2020 when the TA cluster started implementation.⁵

4. The coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic poses challenges for gender mainstreaming during project processing, implementation, monitoring, and reporting. Restricted mobility remains one of the greatest challenges, exacerbating already existing concerns, such as poverty, gender inequality, and social exclusion. Gender interventions designed in pre-COVID

situations may not be enough to address the targeted gender issues in the current COVID situation. Continuous capacity development and technical guidance to executing/implementing agencies on the implementation, monitoring, and reporting of gender action plans (GAPs) need to be sustained amidst the evolving new normal.

5. Subproject 3 will continue to support gender mainstreaming operations in Central and West Asia.⁶ The subproject will assist projects in the integration of gender design features to meet GEN/EGM requirements in the current COVID context. It will determine key gender actions to address gender issues specific to the project scope that are aligned with the pillar of ADB's operational plan for gender equality.⁷ To meet EGM requirements, this will include the development of subprojects that will provide gender mainstreaming TA support to specific loan projects in the difficult sectors of energy, transport, and public finance. The subproject will also carry on with the activities of subprojects 1 and 2, specifically, support to the implementation of GAPs, collection and review of semi-annual GAP updates, and reporting on gender equality results through the preparation of gender sections for project completion reports. Subproject 3 will further refine the gender database that was developed under Subproject 2 and conduct training/s on populating the fields with relevant data from the GAPs of completed projects that align with the gender indicators in the ADB Corporate Results Framework, as well as on generating reports.⁸ The subproject will also conduct an assessment of the 3-year implementation of the TA cluster and look into the challenges, lessons learned, and ways forward in mainstreaming gender in ADB operations. This will include identifying potential projects for gender mainstreaming and other activities to be included in a future cluster TRTA. The subproject will support gender capacity building of executing and implementing agencies of ADB projects to enhance implementation of project GAPs and monitoring and reporting on gender equality results. Such capacity building activities will include in-country workshops and a subregional workshop.

B. Subproject Outputs and Activities

6. The major outputs and activities are summarized in Table 1.

C. Subproject Cost and Financing

7. The TA subproject is estimated to cost \$415,000 which will be financed on a grant basis by ADB's Technical Assistance Special Fund (\$208,000 TASF-7 and \$207,000 TASF-other sources).⁹ The key expenditure items are listed in Appendix 1.

D. Subproject Implementation Arrangements

8. ADB will administer the subproject. The Portfolio, Results, Safeguards, and Gender Unit (PSG) in CWRD will be responsible for administering the subproject in close coordination with resident missions and sector divisions. It will select, supervise, and evaluate consultants. The subproject will be implemented from October 2021 to December 2022.

9. **Consulting services.** ADB will engage the consultants to support the implementation of the subprojects. These will comprise (i) 36 person-months of individual international inputs, of which 12 person-months will be for Azerbaijan and Pakistan, 12 person-months for Kazakshtan, Kyrgyz Republic, and Turkmenistan, and 12 person-months of individual international inputs to be based in ADB headquarters (one full-time) and (ii) 36 person-months of individual national inputs (12 person-months each to be based in Pakistan, Tajikistan, and Armenia). The procurement of consulting services will be carried out in accordance with “ADB Procurement Policy (2017 as amended from time to time) and associated staff instructions.”¹⁰
