### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Implementation of the State and Peace Building Fund activities carried out in parallel with the Third Village Investment Project (VIP3) has proceeded well. The grant financed the capacity building and social mobilization activities for the community and local government actors involved in the participatory planning and decision-making over the cycle 1 subproject village investments. This enable VIP3 project to gear up quickly once the project became effective. Cycle 1 capacity building and social mobilization activities are now complete, and the second round of activities is starting. The levels of awareness and participation in local decision-making processes for citizens was reportedly 71% and local self-government administrations, 81% against a target of 75%. Knowledge of council members increased more significantly to 81%, against a target of 60%. The

grant will close as planned on December 31, 2016.


