## Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project was approved by the World Bank's Board of Directors on April 22, 2015 and was subsequently approved by the Presidential Cabinet of the Republic of Uganda. Parliamentary approval is pending- and is a country specific requirement- before the Financing Agreement can be signed and made effective. An effectiveness date of August 2015 is still the target though it is unlikely the MoESTS will be able to hire all core staff for its Project Coordination Unit, which is a condition of effectiveness. The conditions of effectiveness are: (i) a signed subsidiary agreement between the Private Sector Foundation of Uganda (PSFU) and the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development (MoFPED); (ii) the establishment of Project Coordination Units within the Ministry of Education, Science, Technology and Sport (MoESTS) and within the PSFU; (iii) the establishment of a functional BTVET Reform Task Force; (iv) the preparation of a Project Operations Manual; and (v) the completion of a detailed annual workplan and budget.

A draft of the Project Operations Manual has been prepared and found to be substantially satisfactory to the IDA team with the incorporation of a section on safeguards. A draft subsidiary agreement has been prepared by PSFU and is awaiting government signatures. The BTVET Reform Task Force has been re-constituted and is functioning. The TORs for the consultants to be hired under the MoESTS and PSFU Project Coordination Units have been cleared by IDA and the recruitment process is to commence in July 2015. A detailed annual workplan and budget are expected to be submitted to IDA by the end of July 2015.

Despite this progress, there have been delays in the key procurement activities such as hiring of core consultants and identifying appropriate twinning partners and an engineering firm for the project. Key procurements are behind schedule and as a result, implementation progress is moderately satisfactory.
