Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project is pending Parliamentary ratification to reach effectiveness, which is a country specific requirement. An effectiveness target of April 2016 is envisaged in light of the upcoming National elections scheduled for February 18th, 2016.

There has been limited progress since the last ISR, and the status of other effectiveness conditions remain largely the same: (I) The Project Operations Manual for the MoESTS is awaiting incorporation of safeguards elements and a detailed workplan and budget for component 1; (ii) a draft subsidiary agreement is pending signature by MoFPED and PSFU; (iii) The BTVET Reform Task Force has been re-constituted and is functioning. Progress has been made on the recruitment process for core consultants under the MoESTS and PSFU Project Coordination Units, though it is not complete. A detailed annual workplan and budget for PSFU has been cleared.

Key procurements remain behind schedule and as a result, implementation progress is moderately satisfactory. In addition, key consultants are yet to be hired and baseline data has not yet been collected


