Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Sixteen months after effectiveness, progress towards achievement of PDO is satisfactory as 4076 beneficiary families (29 percent of project target) are starting nutrition-sensitive improvements in their agricultural production systems. Also: (i) USD 6,4 million (28 percent of projected IDP funding) are committed in 14 Innovation Development Plans (IDP) and; (ii) approx. USD 4,1 million in 13 new IDPs are being prepared for approval before December, 2016. Implementation progress is considered moderately satisfactory. To date, the project has disbursed USD 4,58 million (85 percent of the target for FY16). The first Annual Audit Report started with some delay but is expected for late July 2016. The Baseline Study is delayed and should be ready by the end of October, 2016. The next implementation support mission is planned for late September, 2016.
