Project Development Objectives

Project Development Objective (from Project Appraisal Document) The PDO is to enable selected poor households to enhance agricultural incomes and secure increased access to human development services and social entitlements.

The "selected poor households" will include households that are geographically & socially excluded and have low income levels. The incomes for these households will be enhanced by ensuring increased incomes from agriculture and allied sectors through increased productivity and enhanced market access. The "human developmentservices" include services related to health, nutrition and sanitation. The "social entitlements" mainly include social safety nets like the wages from National RuralEmployment Guarantee Scheme, pensions and insurance benefits that are provided by the government.

Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project is structured into 3 key program Components a) Value Chain Development: focusing on improving incomes of 250,000 small and marginal farmers by at least 50%; b) Human Development: aimed at improving health, nutrition and sanitation behaviors of 250,000 poor households and c) Access to Social Protection Services and Entitlements: with an objective to improve coverage and service delivery of social protection entitlements of 500,000 of poorest households.

While the project was approved by the board in December 2014, the project only became effective in Feb, 2016 due to the restructuring of the project necessitated by the changes to the financing agreement. Thus there is a lag of nearly 1 year of project implementation. On November 19, 2015, Shri. Chandrababu Naidu, Hon. Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh officially launched the project. Under Component 1, the focus during the period has been on mobilization of producer groups, productivity enhancement interventions, partnership with private sector for marketing support and convergence with Government Schemes. In Component 2, protocols have been developed for implementation of comprehensive Human Development plans in 9 pilot Gram Panchayats. In Component 3, 15 One-stop shops have been setup across 3 districts, which provide business correspondent services and delivery of social entitlements (Pensions) through Village-Level Entrepreneurs. As part of component 4, the Technical Support Agaency working with the project has completed a scoping study that will enable the project to initiate integration of the different existing IT applications. As part of component 5, there has been a significant effort to recruit staff at multiple levels across components, a head hunting firm has been contracted for the state level recruitment and significant progress has also been made on strengthening the Monitoring, Learning, and Evaluation system.




