Project Development Objectives

Project Development Objective (from Project Appraisal Document)

The primary Project Development Objective (PDO) is to improve national water resources management by involving the localcommunities to play an expanded role in all stages of the participatory scheme cycle management. The secondary objective is toenhance institutional performance of the Country's principal water institutions, particularly BWDB and WARPO. This is expected toresult in reduced vulnerability and enhanced livelihood opportunities for the beneficiaries, and will also create a favorableenvironment for improved water resources management.

The Project Development Objective (PDO) is to improve water resources management by improving infrastructure and institutions through rehabilitating damaged water infrastructure, piloting the role of local communities and enhancing the institutional performance of the Country's principal water institutions, particularly BWDB and WARPO.



Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The implementation progress remains good since last mission. All agreed actions are completed and additional progress has been achieved under various components. The overall scope of the project is spread in 39 districts of the country and to date the project has achieved the following results: -- 685 km of embankments rehabilitated

- -- 329 water control structures reconstructed
- -- 29 km of protective works repaired
- -- 500,000 households are directly benefitting
- -- 12 million person-days of employment generated
- -- 785 Water Management Organizations (WMOs) formed
- -- 377 WMOs registered under the Chief Water Management (CWM) cell
- -- 785 WMOs have been provided with training

The rehabilitation of irrigation, drainage and river bank protection infrastructure has improved an area of 800,579 ha, reaching a population of 9.5 million. The Sirajganj Hardpoint (SHP) works are completed. The Flood Damage Rehabilitation (FDR) works are nearly completed.

The irrigation sector reforms initiated under this project are progressing with the devolved O&M of completed schemes through Water Management Organizations (WMOs). To date a total of 785 WMGs and 72 WMAs have been formed in the 67 schemes financed under WMIP. The BWDB is keen to initiate dialogue on future support for strengthening and sustaining the newly formed Water Management Organizations (WMOs) that were supported through the WMIP. By the closure of the current project, the legal registration, training, and joint operations and maintenance (O&M) trial management activities will be completed. However, to ensure WMOs remain functional and engage in visible role of participatory irrigation management, these new structures would require additional support.

The overall disbursements are at 93%. The FM performance of the Water Resources Planning Organization (WARPO) has improved. WARPO has hired a consultant to provide dedicated FM reporting support. The reconciled IUFRs are prepared and sent to Bank for review. The overall FM performance rating is maintained as Moderately Satisfactory in this ISR and a review for upgrading this rating will be done at next mission. Overall, the project implementation is on track and the PDO and IP ratings are maintained at Satisfactory.






