Due Diligence Report - Social Safeguards on Muktagacha Pourashava

Resettlement team (PPTA) has visited Muktagacha Pourashava from 19 to 21 July 2014 and covered all of phase-1 subproject components. The team, accompanied by Pourashava's Assistant Engineer, visited all proposed locations. The team found only road 5 and 13 were proposed for construction and rest all roads have been proposed for improvement. The team closely investigated and identified no impacts along the RoW (right of way) of the proposed roads and drainage locations. The roads and drainage alignment have sufficient space for reconstruction and improvement.

Detailed information about roads and drains are provided below:

Drainage improvement

There is sufficient space along ROWs to construct the proposed Phase 1 drains (D-1 to D-4). It has been noted that there are no structures, encroachers/ squatters and/or mobile vendors/ hawkers along the proposed alignment and ROWs of these drains.

There is sufficient space for a staging area, construction equipment, and stockpiling of materials. However, the contractor will need to remove all construction and demolition wastes on a daily basis as per subproject environmental management plan (EMP).

Roads improvement

There is sufficient space along carriageways for Phase 1 roads (R-1, R2, R-3, R-5 to R-11 and R-13). The carriageways are free from encroachers and there are no existing structures along proposed alignments. It has also been noted during the field visits there are no mobile vendors/ hawkers along the identified alignments.

There is sufficient space for staging areas, construction equipment, and stockpiling of materials in all Phase 1 roads. However, the contractor will need to remove all construction and demolition wastes on a daily basis as per subproject EMP.

The complete indicative list of subprojects in Muktagacha is summarized in the following table.

Phase 1 implementation will involve (i) construction of 4.818 km of drainage; (ii) improvement of 7.603 km of existing roads.)

The subprojects to be implemented went through the process of meeting the selection criteria (general and technical), environmental and social safeguard screening and conforming to the master plan (draft) prepared for Muktagacha. Locations and siting of the proposed infrastructures considered: (i) locating components on government-owned land and/or within existing right-of-way (ROW) to reduce acquisition of land, (ii) prioritizing rehabilitation over new construction; (iii) taking all possible measures in design and selection of sites to avoid resettlement impacts; (iv) avoiding where possible locations that will result in destruction/disturbance to historical and cultural places/values; (v) avoiding tree-cutting where possible; and (vi) ensuring all planning and design interventions and decisions are made in

consultation with local communities and reflecting inputs from public consultation and disclosure for site selection.



Observably, since there will be no social impact vis-a-vis resettlement issues involved (ref matrix above), it is felt that no preparation of **Resettlement Plan** (RP) will be needed for Muktagacha Pourashava

Notably, during feasibility study, the resettlement (Social Safeguard) team only focused on all components under phase-1 period. However, there are a number of roads, drains and other infrastructures that have been proposed to be implemented in Phase-2 and 3. The resettlement team under Management, Design and Supervision (MDS) of PMO will focus on the pertinent location to identify probable impacts and will accordingly take appropriate initiative to avoid /minimize impacts and mitigate them with compensatory measures as outlined in ADB guidelines.
