Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The World Bank Board of Executive Directors approved the US\$21 million loan for the Third Public Sector Modernization Project (PSMP-III) for Armenia on September 30, 2015. The project will further assist the Government of Armenia in its on-going efforts to improve quality of the public financial reporting and to improve access to selected enhanced e-government services.

PSMP-III includes three main components:

- 1) Public Financial Management Information Systems;
- 2) e-Governance Solutions for Improved Service Delivery; and
- 3) Capacity Building and Small Capacity Building Interventions.

The loan agreement is currently in the process of ratification, which will be completed after Armenian National Assembly will reconvene the sessions in February 2016.
