Description	The TA is category B and it aims to enhance the environmental sustainability of the project focusing on the protection and long-term conservation of the valuable biodiversity at the Baluran and Bali Barat national parks through the institutional strengthening of the two park authorities. This will ensure the viability of the protected area network and the survival of endangered species, adequate institutional capacity to monitor the implementation of the project's environmental management plan, and biodiversity conservation measures in accordance with international and national best practices.
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	Potential impacts on endangered species were identified during the due diligence of the project. Therefore, the project is classified as environmental category "A", based on ADB's Safeguard Policy Statement (SPS) 2009. During project design and processing, an environmental impact assessment (EIA) was undertaken and it was recommended that SERD prepare a small-scale technical assistance (SSTA) for institutional strengthening of Baluran and Bali Barat National Park Authorities to address residual biodiversity impacts and risks in the protected areas. The SSTA is intended to ensure compliance with SPS 2009 requirements to achieve "no net loss" of biodiversity due to the loans 3083/8276 project.
