## **Environmental Aspects**

As an equity investment, this will be classified as environmental category FI. Given the nature and general location of projects to be financed by the loan, the investment has been classified as B/C under the ADB Involuntary Resettlement Policy (1995) and B from the perspective of the ADB Policy on Indigenous Peoples (1998). The JVC will implement an environmental and social management system (ESMS) fully consistent with ADB's safeguard policies, and will screen, assess, and monitor projects at the appropriate stage of due diligence. The JVC will covenant not to finance activities on ADB's list of prohibited investments.
