### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This ISR has been updated based on findings of the supervision and support mission which was implemented from November 23-28, 2015.

- 1. Overall the project performance is rated as satisfactory. The project became effective on January 29, 2015. The disbursement rate has increased from to 10.14 in June to 13.00 percent for IDA credit while the counterpart funding has been dibursed a 13.71 percent.
- 2. The commodity-based public-private consultation platform was officially launched and held its first meetings in September 2015.
- 3. Eight buyer agribusinesses are engaged with the Project of which seven have signed a partnership with the project to resource material from cooperatives (POs) up to more than 120,000 tons.
- 4. Contracts for the procurement of two sorghum processing plants for two cooperatives have been signed.
- 5. The third portfolio of 24 business plans has been prepared and negotiations between cooperatives, buyer agribusinesses and commercial banks will be completed latest by January 31, 2016.
- 6. Preparation of the fourth group of 33 business plans will be completed by June 2016.
- 7. The mission has reviewed thoroughly the preparation process of business plans and adjusted the process to (i) frarme it into 6 months maximum, and (ii) expedite a) signing of purchase contracts, b) processing of cooperative credit applications, and c) disbursement after competion of business plans. Considering the action plan which was agreed with the Government, the task team is confident that the project team will expedite registration of cooperatives as well as implementation of cooperative business plans.
- 8. The draft agricultural insurance production within the project was completed by Activa company and will be submitted to the minsitry of agriculre's review and approval prior to the organization of a national consultation and validation workshop.
- 9. An initiative on climate smart agriculture. From December 2-4, 2015, the World Bank, in partnership with the project coordination unit, organized in Douala Cameroon, a training workshop on climate change adaptation and mitigation through sustainable agricultural land management. The training was organized at the request of cooperatives representatives during the June 2015 workshop on business plans. The training objective was to enhance the capacity of the PIDMA staff and cooperatives on climate change impact and risk screening tools, building climate resilience and adaptation for food security, and integrating mitigation with adaption measures using the landscape approach. The training covered the topic of "Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation for Sustainable Agricultural Land Management". Participants came from Ministry of Agriculture, national and regional PIDMA offices, agribusiness cooperatives and farmer organizations. The training evaluation was collected with positive feedback participants found the training not only useful and also practical. Many participants expressed their plans to incorporate the knowledge from this training into their daily work and project implementation.
