Amendment to Loan Agreement

- 1. We refer to the Loan Agreement (Special Operations) dated 27 May 2014 between the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka ("Borrower") and Asian Development Bank ("ADB") ("Loan Agreement") for the Skills Sector Enhancement Program ("Program"), where ADB agreed to lend to the Borrower from ADB's Special Funds resources an amount in various currencies equivalent to thirty two million six hundred thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR32,600,000). All capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning given thereto in the Loan Agreement, unless the context requires otherwise.
- 2. On 4 October 2015, the Borrower requested ADB to amend DLI 9 and include Ceylon German Technical Training Institute as an implementing agency of the Program.
- 3. On 23 November 2015, ADB approved the proposed changes to the Program. To give effect to the changes, ADB proposes that Attachment 1 to Schedule 3 of the Loan Agreement be amended as follows:

9. DLI9: Improved medium term skills sector budgeting and expenditure

- 6. Please indicate the Borrower's concurrence to the amendment set out in paragraph 3 of this letter agreement and to the terms of this letter agreement, by countersigning each of the two originals of this letter agreement in the space indicated below. Please retain one fully signed original of this letter agreement for your records and return the other to ADB. The amendment as set out in paragraph 3 of this letter agreement shall take effect on the date of receipt by ADB of a fully-signed original of this letter agreement.
