1	Students benefiting from new or improved educational facilities	704,000 (Girls: 216,000)	This indicates approximate number of students benefiting from information and communication technology learning centers at 640 schools and madrasahs (512,000 students), and prevocational and vocational courses at 640 schools and madrasahs (192,000 students).
2	Teachers trained with quality standards	320,000 teachers (Female: 72,800)	This indicates approximate number of teachers from secondary schools (240,000 teachers) and madrasahs (80,000) who receive major national training on curriculum dissemination with updated standards, examination, and assessment.
3	Students educated and trained under improved quality assurance systems	12 million (Girls: 6.4 million)	This indicates approximate number of students from secondary schools (9.74 million) and madrasahs (2.25 million) who benefit from the new curriculum delivery and assessment.
