

Implementation Status Overview

The project was signed on July 22, 2013 and declared effective on October 16, 2013 after completing the three effectiveness conditions. The Project Coordination Unit (PCU) is anchored within the Cellule d'exécution des financements en faveur des etats fragiles or CFEF, unit put in place within the Ministry of Finance by AfDB. Additional staff have been competitively recruited to strengthen the CFEF which is fully operational since February 2014. The project was launched officially in Kinshasa on April 26, 2014.



IMPLEMENTATION PROGRESS: Training has been carried out to PCU staff in procurement and financial management. A communication strategy has been prepared in close collaboration with the Bank's senior communication officer. A results monitoring system is being put in place, in parallel with the Impact Evaluation work being carried out by the Bank's PREM team (Gender Lab), focusing on impact of project activities under Component 1 on beneficiaries of agricultural extension services and rural roads rehabilitation in the Bas-Congo, with a special focus on women's productivity.

At the project level, good progress has been made on preparing and negotiating Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) and contracts with key stakeholders identified during project preparation involved in the implementation of Component 1 (Agriculture Value Chains Development in Bas-Congo). Final documents have been submitted to the Bank for NO and are currently being reviewed by technical and procurement teams, as follows:

- MoU with INERA on the production of basic seeds and seedlings (2.878.000 USD);
- MoU with SENASEM on the certification of seeds produced by INERA and registration of agricultural multipliers (4.112.277 USD);
- MoU with DVDA on the monitoring of rehabilitation and maintenance of rural roads and capacity building of beneficiaries and structures (600.000 USD).

The following contracts will be submitted by the PCU in the coming weeks for Bank review:

• Technical assistance contract with SNV for capacity building of producers' organizations in project areas, in collaboration with FOPAKO (Farmers' Coalition of Kongo);

• Technical assistance contract with ONUDI for the establishment of technical platforms for agro-processing in Tshela and Lukula, a laboratory in Kimpese and capacity building for the local GIEs (Groupements d'Intéret Economique) in project areas.

All technical studies for the 500 km of rural roads that will be rehabilitated under this project have been prepared. They are expected to be submitted for Bank review by June 20, 2014.

The project has occurred delays in the implementation of Component 2 (Special Economic Zone of Maluku) due to internal discussions on the strategic direction that the SEZ should take. However, the team has made progress in the last month on moving this component forward. Terms of reference for the transaction adviser that will assist the Government in competitively selecting a private developer for the SEZ have been prepared. The budget covering staff of the existing CAZES, unit following up on SEZ activities within the Ministry of Industry, has been prepared.

On Component 3 (Proactive Business development), a technical note laying out the implementation of activities and ToRs to recruit firms that will work on trade facilitation at the Port of Matadi and business reforms have been reviewed by the Bank.

The disbursements to date are US\$4.45 million (4 percent) against a projected disbursement of US\$2 million for this Fiscal Year (till June 30, 2014). A couple of contracts (INERA, SENASEM and DVDA) are expected to be signed before the end of the FY, which would help increase levels of disbursement with the 20 percent initial down payment (additional US \$1.5 million).


