Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project is showing good progress on all the components now; very good progress on household Sanitation component. The Head of the Department (HOD) is now full time and he was able to fill-in a large number of vacant positions at all levels. This has enabled the project to demonstrate qualitative improvements on community development, IEC, etc.The project is still not able to show good financial progress; not commensurate with the physical progress mainly due to cash flow problems. The Bank has agreed to treat first installment releases to beneficiaries to construct toilets as reimbursable expenditure to improve cash flows. Project to focus more on service delivery, strengthening water and sanitation committees at village level, appointment of independent verification agencies and to improve disbursements.
