Project Description	The project is designed to reduce the severity of the pandemic, save lives, and minimize adverse social-economic disruptions. The project aims at getting priority populations safely vaccinated against severe forms of COVID-19 by helping the Government of Cambodia to procure, deliver, and deploy vaccines. The project will support the procurement of an estimated 11.6 million eligible COVID-19 vaccines under Asian Development Bank (ADB)'s Asia Pacific Vaccine Access Facility (APVAX) ¹ , contributing to the government's goal of vaccinating target populations. Vaccines will be procured through bilateral negotiations and agreements with potential manufacturers of APVAX-eligible COVID-19 vaccines, in compliance with leading co-financier ADB's procurement policy. ADB will provide technical assistance to the Government of Cambodia in selected areas to support the implementation of its National Deployment and Vaccination Plan in parallel with this project.					
Objective	To increase access to eligible COVID-19 vaccines for priority populations in Cambodia.					
Expected Results	 a) Vaccination of about 5.4 million people in target populations, disaggregated by gender, against COVID-19 based on the Vaccination Plan COVID-19; b) About 11.6 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines delivered to Central Medical Store; and c) Guidelines on the deployment and administration of vaccines, addressing the specific needs of women and other
