Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project is effective since January 21, 2015. The official launch of the project was held in Kinshasa on March 19, 2015 in presence of H.E. the Vice-Prime Minister for Telecom, H.E. the Minister of Portfolio, and H.E. the Vice-Minister for Telecom.

It is urgent to mobilize all available resources to fulffill the disbursement conditions: (i) creation of the SPN and conclusion of cooperation agreement between SPN and the Government (ii) adoption of the legal and regulatory framework by the Government and presentation at the next Parliamentary session and, (iii) draft of the roadmap for SCPT restructuring and launch of the preparatory work (technical studies and bidding documentation) for the rehabilitation of Moanda-Kinshasa link.

According to the dated legal covenants stated in the Financing Agreement, the creation of the SPN, the recruitement of key staff (SPN General Manager, Procurement specialist, Financial management specialist, Accounting and Assistant) and the recruitment of the project focal points should be done by no more than three months after effectiveness i.e. no later than April 21, 2015.

In terms of implementation, during the PPA execution, the PIU recruited the Investment bank in charge of structuring the future PPP between the SPN and private operators. The consoritum includes an investment bank and an engineering firm that will carry out all necessary technical studies before launching the tender for the construction. The PIU also recruited the environmental and social specialists, as well as the communication agency that will promote the project, raise awareness about the benefits of CAB5 among the communities located along the future CAB5 infrastructure. The selection of the consultant in charge of drafting the SCPT restructuring roadmap in on-going and should be completed by April 30, 2015.

Regarding the fiduciary aspects, the project closed the PPA account and opened a new designated account for the IDA Grant. The specimen of signatures have been transmitted to the Bank.


