GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

1. The Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has received a grant from the African Development Fund to finance the Borana Resilient Water Development for Improved Livelihoods Program (BRWDILP) Phase II.

2. The principal objectives of this project are to:

The Program objective is to improve access to climate resilient and gender sensitive integrated and sustainable water and sanitation services by pastoral communities in dryland areas of the Borana area of the Oromia region. Specific objectives include: (i) improve access of the people to improved water supply and sanitation services (ii) improve water access for livestock and (iii) improve catchment management for reduced degradation. It will lead to the creation of jobs for both men and women in the affected communities.

All Goods, Works, Non- Consultancy Services & Consultancy Services required for the Program and to be financed out of the proceeds of the Grant shall be procured in accordance with the provisions of the Procurement Framework & the Recipient's Procurement Plan for the Program in competitive approach.

3. The project includes the following components:

- Component 1: Water Infrastructure Development and Improved Sanitation
- Component 2: Water Resources Management and Institutional Strengthening
- Component3: Project Management. The main procurement activities will include Construction of Main Trunk (24km pipes and fittings supply and installation); Construction of wellfield distribution backbone water supply and sanitation infrastructures; Construction of Dubuluk and Weib distribution sub-system and construction supervision.

4. Procurement of goods and/or works will be in accordance with the Bank's Rules of Procedure for the Procurement of Goods and Works. Acquisition of the services of consultants will follow the Bank's Rules of Procedure for the Use of Consultants. The African Development Bank (AfDB) shall arrange the publication on its external website of the agreed initial procurement plan and all subsequent updates once it has provided a no objection. Specific procurement notices for contracts subject to open international competitive procurement will be announced, as they become available, in UNDB online and in the Bank's Internet Website. Bidding documents are expected to be available in August 2024.
